## **Fundraising Protocol**

<u>Internal events:</u> From time to time Faith Lutheran College Redlands seeks to raise monies internally from the student population in service of various charities and causes. As a general rule the college will only seek to do so once per term on each site so as to avoid repeated requests of families for additional costs in having their children attend the college. Participation in these events is not compulsory. On any given day or event students attend the college as per usual and can opt out of participation and thus not be expected to contribute to the fundraising.

**External events:** From time to time the college may host external events such as Trivia Nights as fundraising for specific causes. These are not covered by this protocol. Parents and Friends Association (P&FA) fundraising is not covered by this protocol.

## **Fundraising/awareness events:**

- Free Dress Days or Similar (usually one per term per site) Gold Coin Donation. Australian Lutheran World Service (ALWS) will be the predominate beneficiary.
- Charity Organisations Community Events (e.g. Kokoda Challenge, Colour Run, MS Read-a-thon) Students are encouraged to be involved and are then responsible for covering the costs of entry fees and any specific fund raising required for the event (fundraising is to be outside of the school).
  - Organisations are most welcome at assembly to share their message/ advocate but we do not fundraise for these organisations.
  - The role of such presentations and sharing is Service.
- Awareness days for Charity Organisations, such as:
  - World's Greatest Shave
  - o Jeans for Genes Wear Jeans
  - Red Nose Day
  - o Bandanna Day Purchase Bandanna
  - o RUOK?
  - No internal fundraising, the primary goal of these days is about awareness.
- One off events and natural disasters: Where ALWS is involved in support for Natural
  Disasters the college will seek to support those efforts with one off fundraising days as
  approved by the College Executive. Where one off events occur such as local fires,
  illness, family calamity etc one off gold coin days may be held as approved by the College
  Executive.
